SETTING UP YOUR

mySTORY CROWDFUNDING PAGE

SET UP YOUR ACCOUNT AT mySTORY.lifesongfororphans.org/get-started

After submitting your campaign, we will review your content and check to make sure your family account number is correct and matches what we have on file. Within 2 business days you will be notified to review your live page and then you can share your page through social media.

PLEASE NOTE

- Remember this is a public website and if you cannot share your child's photo on social media, you shouldn't share it here.
- 2 Lifesong prohibits auctions, raffles, and other fundraisers involving the exchange of goods and/or services through mySTORY as we cannot receipt these as tax-deductible donations.
- Since mySTORY is an online crowdfunding site, donations are processed through STRIPE and their fees do apply. Your mySTORY page will not reflect STRIPE fees, but they will be reflected in your family fund report.
 - mySTORY only reflects donations made through your page. To see your complete, actual accounts, please log on to your family fund report.

GUIDE TO SUCCESS

- ► Tell your story from the beginning. Don't write a novel, but clearly define your goal. Why are you adopting? How has God confirmed your story? How can others join you in your journey? How will their donation be used?
- Don't just share the dollars you are needing by a certain time. Donors connect with stories.
- ► Use compelling photos and videos.
- Share your page on Facebook, Twitter, on a personal blog, email, everywhere. You can do this on your dashboard.
- Celebrate and update each adoption milestone, unexpected large (& small donations). Thank your donors.
- Finish strong. If you are \$1000 short with 1 day to go, **share your need**.
- mySTORY is a tool for families to use, but the LORD provides the increase. Remember to pray for your story to be funded in HIS timing.







WRITING YOUR FUNDRAISING LETTER

FOLLOWING ARE SOME GUIDELINES TO ASSIST YOU IN WRITING YOUR SUPPORT LETTER:

- Briefly give your adoption testimony and how God led you to this point.
- If possible, include a picture and name of the child you are adopting.
- Ask for prayer for your family, your child, your adoption process, specifics to your situation.
- ► Ask for financial support and specifically state the amount needed.
- State matching grant amount and who funded the matching grant.
- Include a "goal date." Funds will be accepted until the child is home or adoption is complete. However, the goal date serves as an encouragement for timely giving.
- ► Make the options for giving very clear.
- Checks should be payable to "Lifesong for Orphans." In the memo, **note family name** and **family account number** to assure it goes to the correct account. Please mail to Lifesong for Orphans, PO Box 40, Gridley, IL 61744. Lifesong has been blessed with partners who underwrite all U.S. administrative and fundraising costs (TMG Foundation and other partners). **That means 100% of your donation will go directly to the adoption**.
- To pay online go to **www.lifesong.org/donate/family**. Select "Give to an Adoptive Family." Complete the online form and fill in "Family Account Number" and "Family Name" fields. NOTE: Your donation is processed by STRIPE with a 2.2% + \$.30 (3.5% for AMEX) per transaction fee. 100% of the donation received by Lifesong will go directly to your account. *If using the mySTORY platform, please direct online donations to your specific mySTORY webpage.

▶ It is important to include the following two points in your letter.

NOTE: In accordance with IRS guidelines, your donation is to the named non-profit organization. This organization retains full discretion over its use, but intends to honor the donor's suggested use.

- Individual donations of \$50 or more and yearly donations totaling \$250 or more will receive a tax-deductible receipt. Receipts for donations under \$50 will gladly be sent upon request. Lifesong is a 501(c)3 tax exempt organization.
- Send as many letters as possible (we suggest 100-200 households of church family, family and friends).
- Use social media—Facebook, Twitter, blogging, etc.

Remember to write "thank you" letters to those who support you.

Please email or mail Lifesong a copy of your fundraising letter when it's completed.

ADDITIONAL FUNDRAISING IDEAS

EVENTS

- Both Hands Project bothhands.org
- BBQ Chicken Dinner or similar (pork chops / spaghetti) to raise \$\$ - use as opportunity to share story and raise awareness
- Bingo Night charge \$5 per card and get prizes donated
- Family Fun Days competitions, \$50 per family to enter, tug of war, hot dog eating, puzzles, etc
- 3 on 3 Basketball Tournaments, get donated prizes, charge for entry fee, snacks, pictures etc
- Dinner/Auctions held at church

CHALLENGES

- > Puzzle Fundraisers sell pieces of a puzzle to complete a picture
- 52-week Saving Challenge start saving \$1 in week 1, \$2 in week 2... \$52 in week 52 – you will have saved over \$1300 – challenge others to join you

SALES

- Sell MudLOVE Bands & Mugs mudLOVE.com
- Design & Sell T-shirts or have <u>fundthenations.com</u> design and print your shirts

NOTE Lifesong for Orphans will not provide a tax-deductible receipt for a "quid pro quo contribution" received for an adoptive family. A quid pro quo contribution is a payment made by a donor partly as a contribution and partly for goods or services provided to the donor because of the contribution.
