Biography & Legacy

Mardie Caldwell, C.O.A.P., is a nationally recognized authority on adoption and a Certified Open Adoption Practitioner. She is the founder and director of Lifetime Adoption (est. 1986) and Nationwide Adoption Services, owning one of the largest adoption agencies in the nation. A pioneer of adoption online, she launched one of the first adoption websites in 1997. From the earliest days of the movement, she was one of the first advocates of Open Adoption, shaping its acceptance nationwide. Her expertise has been sought by lawmakers: she was invited by a California State Senator to present testimony before the California State Assembly, contributing to the passage of two adoption laws designed to make adoption safer and more ethical. She has also served as an expert witness in contested adoption cases and is a frequent public speaker at adoption conferences, women's leadership events, and family-focused seminars. As an adoptive mother, Mardie understands the heartbreak of infertility and the lifelong joy of parenting an adopted child. She is also known for her philanthropy and humanitarian work, extending her compassion to projects in the United States, the Far Bahamas, Uganda, and Mexico.
